Academic Year 2023-24

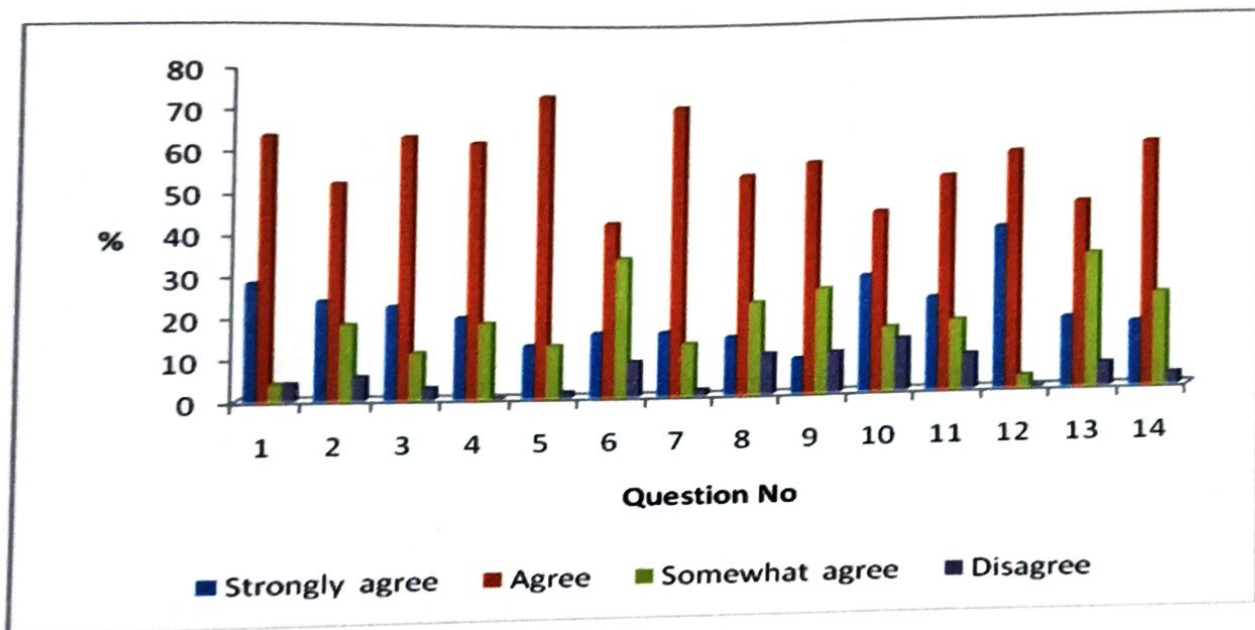
The teachers' feedback survey over syllabus was carried out for the academic year 2023-24 using a well-structured Google form through online mode. 14 questions were analyzed using Likert scale. The total number respondent was 71.

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From the above table, it was observed that for all the questions regarding syllabus orientation, majority of the teachers strongly agreed or agreed (collectively) for all the questions. For question number 5, and 12, close to 40% of the teachers collectively disagreed or strongly disagreed with the fact that syllabus is well structured and organized to guide the teachers and paper setters, and the internal assessment will help the students to improve their grades respectively. Thus the overall survey reflected that overall, the teachers are satisfied with the course. In the academic session 2023-24, the college conducted quite a few placement drives for the students which reflected in the fact that the students found the curriculum to be more suitable for bridging the gap between academics and industry, as compared to the academic session 2022-23. However, teachers' opinion reveals that issues related to syllabus structure, an internal assessment process require further reforms.

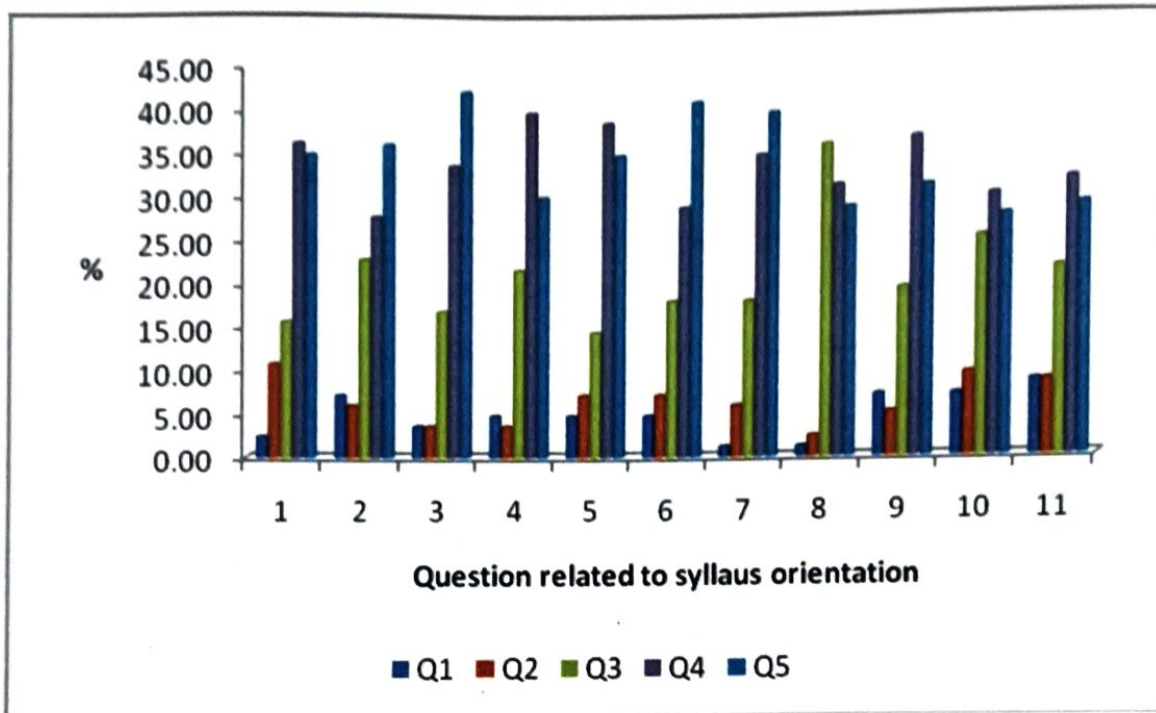

From the above table, it was observed that most of the students' responded regarding syllabus orientation was either excellent or towards excellent (Likart scale 4 & 5). Besides, it was noted that more than 90% students' were highly satisfied in case of the internal assessment of the college (regularity, transparency etc) and Internal assessment related queries are addressed

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adequately. Conversely, more than 5% of the students were responded as not satisfied (Likart scale 1) with the laboratory infrastructure, usage of teaching aids and ICT in the class by faculty to facilitate teaching-learning process, add-on / certificate courses offered, which will be addressed in the future planning of the college as a whole.

Academic Year 2023-24

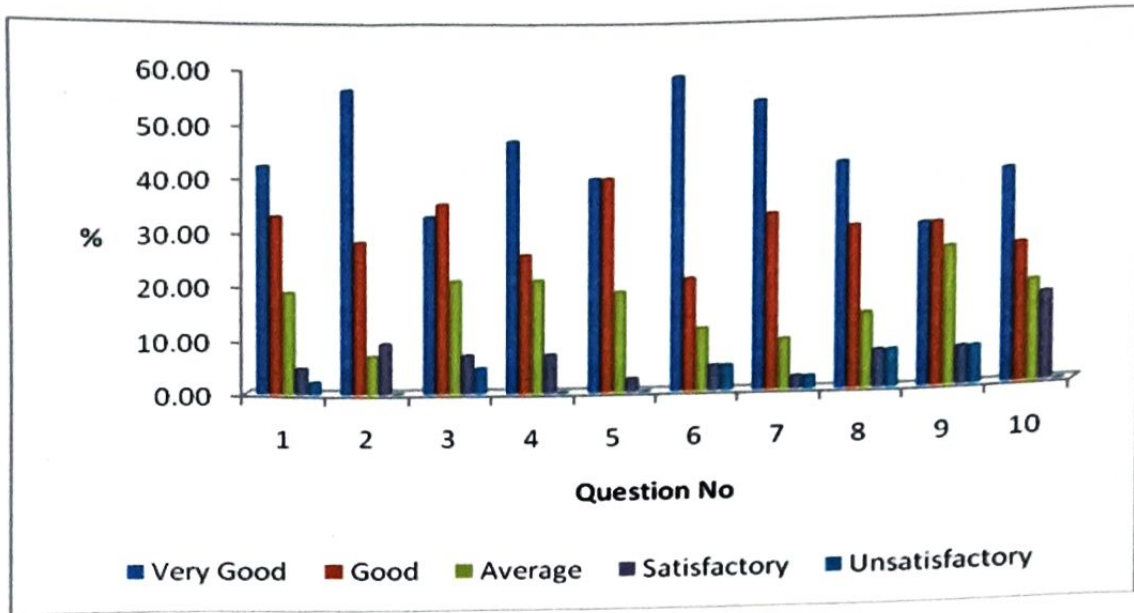
