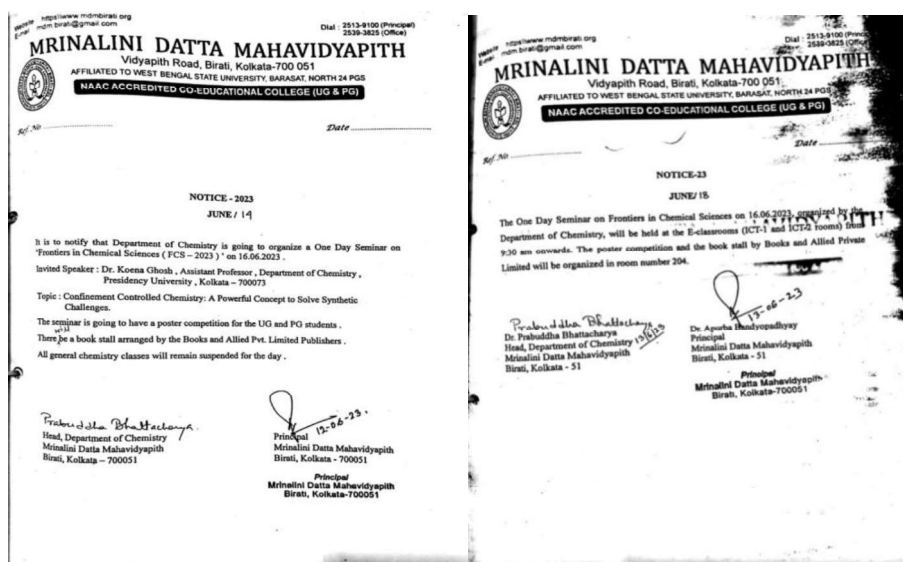
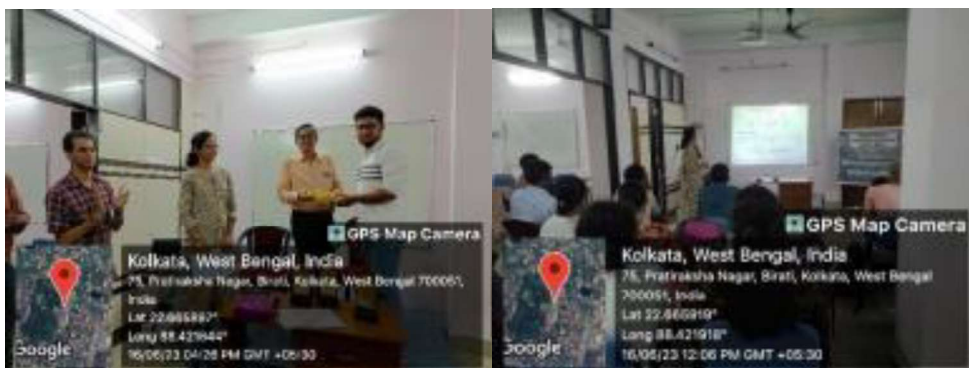


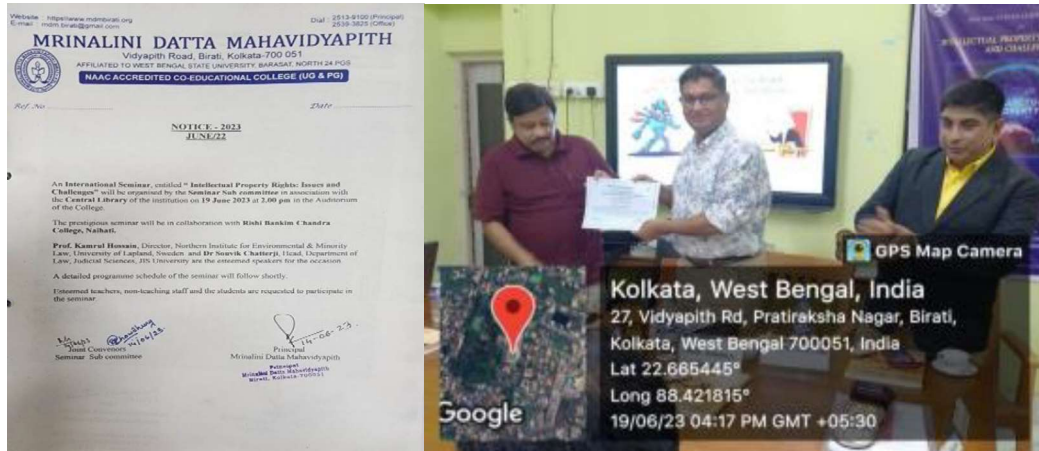

This session 2023-2024, our institution had organized the following seminars and workshops altogether.

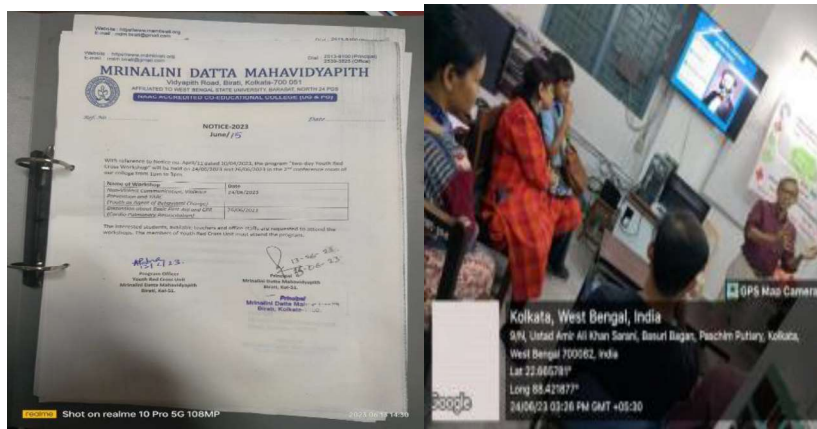
